

Checked the control panels, looked to see if any fault lights were on, checked the volts and amps on the control board, and checked the water level inside the station. Talked to the pump monitor on how their shift was going and if they had any issues.

Checked on Hawthorne pump station. Went inside to check the water level. Tracking the water level since the river went above 410.00

Checked on EA 2 pump station. Went inside the station to check the water level on the sanitary side. While I was in there, I heard water running in the dry sump. Went down in the sump and noticed water running out of the wall. Also noticed a relief valve was broken on #4 sanitary pump pipe. I had Mike and Johnathan put in a high pressure plug to replace the broken valve and Mike plugged the hole in the wall with slithers of wood to stop the leak. Job well done by Mike and Johnathan.

Checked on Grassy pump station. Water was still getting out on gravity Illinois Electric Works went through the pump stations to inspect the cranes

Wehrle on top of the roof at Wood River pump station was squeaking. Sprayed it down with nut buster to lubricate it

Monitoring Wood River pump station by us on day shift .Going inside the station and checking on #1 pump and checking the water level.

Ran EA 1 with two pumps till 10:00 am to maintain the water level for the COE
