2. Relief Well #2 design

- USACE seeks to drill pilot holes on WR property, then IDOT, then East Alton
- 38 of 47 borings drilled so far
- The drillers should be finished in the next 2 weeks. However, the Miss River is coming up which may delay the work until flood waters receded below a stage of 21-ft on the Mel Price TW gage.

3. Powerplant demolition

- No issues identified with smokestack demolition
- Seismic readings were minimal

4. Phillips 66 Pipeline Replacement Section 408 Permission Request

- The applicant is proposing to replace approximately 1.5 miles of the existing WR-16-010 and 17-010 pipelines running from the Hartford Terminal to the Hartford Marine dock.
- USACE 408 review nearly complete.

Stream Bank Erosion Repair Project (2019-01)

- o Areas 1-3 Complete.
- o Area 4 Modification to agreement has been executed.
 - Access Agreement with Olin Winchester, LLC has been partially executed and insurance certificates provided.
 - Project delayed due to Access Agreement with Olin Winchester, LLC. for 27-weeks.
 - Contractor will execute after Agreement is executed. The window to complete this project prior to spring rains has been missed.

Gravity Drains Inspection Project (2020-02)

- EWF Design Complete. Execution scheduled for FY2021.
 - Apparent low bidder is ARDL, Inc. Approximately \$7k under budget.
 - Project delayed due to Access Agreement with Olin Winchester, LLC. for 21-weeks.
- UWR Design Complete.
 - 3 of 5 drains inspected in March 2021.
- LWR Design will be completed in FY2021. Execution scheduled for FY2023.
 - Design underway. Will be complete NLT 28 May 2021.

• Hawthorne Penstock Sluice Gate Replacement Project (2021-04)

- o The gate has been ordered from Hydro-Kinetics.
- o Gate installation work order has been executed with Keller Construction.
- o Gate installation slated for May/June 2021, pending river elevations.

Relief Well Testing / Inspection Project (Project Number TBD)

- o SOP received from the USACE on November 5, 2020. USACE to address follow-up questions.

System-Wide Improvement Framework (SWIF) LOI

Submitted to the USACE 04 OCT 2019. USACE responded with additional comments. WRDLD will
resubmit after FEMA certification of all three levee segments.
