

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-01 (AMENDMENT 01)

**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT PAY POLICY FOR COMMISSIONERS**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of the Wood River Drainage and Levee District wish to adopt a new pay procedure for the WRDLD Commissioners.

**WHEREAS**, this resolution amends Resolution 2021-01, that became effective January 1, 2021.




**WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commissioners of the Wood River Drainage and Levee District, Madison County, Illinois, to adopt the following Pay Policy for the Commissioner's effective January 1, 2021, and later amended on May 27, 2022.

**Commissioner Pay Policy:**


- Commissioners are paid bi-weekly. Pay periods begin on a Wednesday and end on a Tuesday, 14 days later. The pay date for each period is the ensuing Friday.
- Commissioners shall submit their signed and dated journal/timesheet a by close of business at the end of each pay period. If timesheets are not received by close of business, compensation for that pay period will be paid on the following regularly scheduled pay date.
- Special circumstances may dictate the need to submit records early. On these rare occasions the early submission dates will be communicated through the Secretary/Treasurer at least one week in advance.
- Commissioners compensation shall be as mandated in 70 ILCS 605. Each commissioner shall receive for their services a sum not to exceed \$30 per day for each day they are engaged in the business of their office, and they shall be reimbursed for their necessary traveling and other expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.
  - Receipts must be turned in for travel reimbursement to the Secretary/Treasurer at the time of request for reimbursement. This should include receipts for meals and hotels for the period of travel. Without backup for a specific trip/inspection, the Commissioners will be allowed to bill 5 miles per day, at the current federal mileage rate, for each day engaged in the business of their office.
  - Commissioners shall not charge more than 5-days per week unless major projects and or flood necessitate additional involvement by the Commissioners.

This resolution to take effect instanter.
